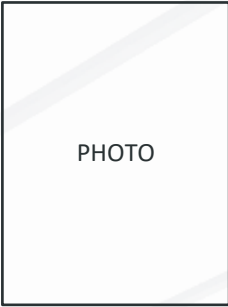

BASES TO AWARD THE COURSE PLACE

- The following documentation must be attached to the application:
 - Proof of payment of registration. (250€).
 - An updated passport size photograph.
 - Photocopy of D.N.I. or Passport.
 - Medical Certificate.
- Once the admission has been communicated and within the period established, a deposit must be made in the bank for the amount of one monthly payment, an amount that will be reimbursed only in the cases established in the Internal Regulations. The deposit will not cover in any case the last month of stay. This amount will be refunded within 60 days of departure from the residence. Only for university reasons the deposit will be returned during the period from 01/09/26 to 15/09/26 (AI).
- The renunciation of the place granted, the disciplinary expulsion or the abandonment of the residence before the end of the academic year of 9 months, will mean the loss of the entire deposit.
- The full monthly payment will be paid during the first 10 days of each month, the full 9 months. The non-payment of two monthly payments will mean the definitive cancellation of the residence, as established in the Internal Regime Regulations.
- All requests will be answered, but the documentation submitted will not be returned.
- Regarding the use of image for advertising, we will abide by what is specified in the Internal Regulations.

SERVICES, FACILITIES AND ACTIVITIES

SERVICES (Included in the fees paid)

- ✦ **Dining service.** From Monday to Sunday, including holidays, it includes breakfast, lunch and dinner. The service is buffet style, with three options of first course and two options of second course to choose, one of them will always be cooked on the grill at the moment and 3 desserts. Also, special or gastronomic days are held. There is the possibility of taking picnic and / or Tupperware for food.
- ✦ **Bed and bath linen.** They have bed and bath linen and washing weekly.
- ✦ **Cleaning service.** Rooms are cleaned once a week. Common areas are cleaned daily.
- ✦ **Internet service.** All rooms have high-capacity wired internet access. We also have Wi-Fi connection both in the rooms and in the common areas of the residence.
- ✦ **Telephone service.** The rooms are equipped with telephone to make internal calls (to Reception and other rooms) as well as to receive calls from outside.
- ✦ **Reception service and video surveillance 24 hours.** Access 24 hours a day, seven days a week with night arrival control. Delivery and collection of mail and parcels and access control.

FACILITIES

- ✦ 170 rooms distributed in: 165 single rooms and 5 double rooms, all with private bathroom, air conditioning and television.
- ✦ Libraries.
- ✦ Study rooms.
- ✦ Rooms for private lessons.
- ✦ Assembly hall.
- ✦ Music Rooms.
- ✦ TV rooms.
- ✦ Gymnasium.
- ✦ Self-service laundry. Washer, dryer and iron available to our residents.
- ✦ Dining room (large capacity).
- ✦ Autovending.
- ✦ Sauna and Jacuzzi.

Tagaste Student Housing Madrid encourages the realization of various cultural, sports, training and leisure activities.

Each area is managed by several commissioners who are responsible for programming, the proper development of the corresponding activities and the interrelation between the different Residences.

Some of these areas are:

- ✦ Area of cultural and training activities: visit to museums in Madrid, its historic area and the nearby monumental cities. Also, training courses and conferences on various topics.
- ✦ Area of social responsibility and volunteer activities: solidarity races, sponsorship.
- ✦ Area of recreational activities: monologues, theater, cinema.
- ✦ Cooking workshops, pastries.

ACTIVITIES

+T ROOMS

- +T The rooms are a place of study and rest, and therefore, in them and in the adjoining corridors, silence should be kept and avoid noise or anything that may disturb colleagues.
- +T At the time of entry, each resident will receive the room in perfect condition of use, as well as the belongings that contain the room. Throughout your stay in the Residence, it is your responsibility to take care of and maintain all this material and must warn of any breakdown or deterioration that occurs in order to solve it as soon as possible.
- +T Each resident will be given a room card. It must be held accountable for it. When you are absent one day, you must leave the card at Reception. The room changes that are requested, during the contract period, will be authorized by the Management.
- +T The Residence is not responsible for the disappearance or deterioration of any personal, material object of work or value (money, jewelry, etc.).

+T COMMON AREAS

- +T The Residence has common spaces and areas, such as: entrance hall, study room, TV room and services (indoor and outdoor), self-service laundry (washing machine, dryer, folding table and ironing board), etc. that are available to residents at certain times.

+T SCHEDULES

- +T The schedules established within the residence, dining room and access to the different facilities must be respected.
- +T The residence will remain open 24 hours a day.
- +T Dining hours:
 - Academic; Saturdays, Sundays and holidays;
 - Breakfast 07:00h to 09:30h Breakfast 09:00h to 11:00h
 - Lunch 13:00h to 15:30h Lunch 13:30h to 16:00h
 - Dinner 20:00h to 22:00h. Dinner 20:00h to 22:00h

+T DINING ROOM

- +T Breakfast - Lunch - Dinner - Desserts will vary daily.
- +T These services are offered throughout the school year, except for the Christmas and Easter holiday periods.
- +T It is not allowed to take Food or crockery out of the dining room.
- +T NOTE: The dining hours indicated above are only alterable when the resident for reasons of class schedules can not maintain them, in which case the food may be served outside the established hours after consultation with Management.
- +T It will be mandatory to present class schedules to justify the reservation of food outside the established hours.

+T CLEANING SERVICE

- +T The staff of the Residence will clean the common areas every day. Weekly the resident will be provided with the change of towels and sheets and the cleaning of the room will be carried out.

+T LAUNDRY

- +T It is the responsibility of the residence to keep bed linen and towels clean.
- +T For the personal clothes of the residents they have at their disposal a service of automatic laundry (washing machine and dryer) that work by means of euro coins.
- +T An ironing area is available to all residents in the immediate vicinity of the laundry.

+T RESIDENCY CALENDAR

- +T The Residence will be governed by the calendar of the academic year (during the Christmas and Easter period the Residence will be closed).
